### I. Background

- Contains a brief historical description of the topic
- Addresses the more immediate consequences/concerns of the topic (i.e. developments and considerations from the past decade of two)
- Explains global significance of topic

### II. Biographical Sketch

- Describes the foreign relations experience of the senator
- Analyzes how the senator changed or remained constant over time, and how they approached issues
- Speaks on their personal view on Vietnam

### III. Possible Solutions

- Created realistic and practical solutions to the issue at hand
- Solutions that are creative and well thought out are highly encouraged
- Solutions that address all sides of the topic will be given more credit than those that lack specificity

### IV. Format and Sources

- Uses proper position paper format as outlined on online document
- Lists used sources (sources must be relevant and robust)
